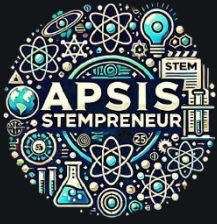

Hands-on robotics challenges and coding activities foster technological skills

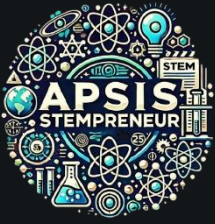
## **3. Pitch Business Ideas –**

### **‘Shark Tank’**

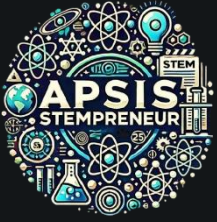
An innovation-based category integrating finance, technology, marketing, and design. Participants will pitch innovative business ideas with STEM at their core.

### **‘Category X (Forensics, Criminology)’**

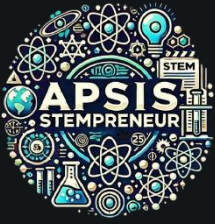
Explore the science behind solving crimes through forensic analysis and criminology.



## DELEGATION FORMAT

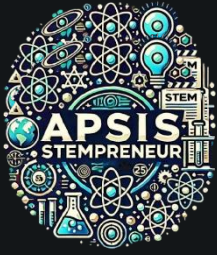


- **Minimum Delegates: 4**
- **Maximum Delegates: 6**
- **Fee per Delegate: Rs. 2,000**
- **Delegation Fee: Rs. 2,500**
- **Note: Private delegates are not allowed; only registered school delegations may participate**
- **20% Discount on Delegation Fee for Early Bird**
- **Early Bird Discount is applicable till 5<sup>TH</sup> Jan**
- **Final Registration Deadline 18<sup>TH</sup> Jan**



## EXECUTION OF COMPETITION

- **Delegates are confirmed after they have filled in the registration form and have paid for the event.**
- **Delegates will be contacted by their competition head 2-3 days before the event to explain the rules of the round, the performance delegates will be judged by external judges to keep the competition fair.**
- **The competition heads will guide the delegates through the competition rules, time limits, and all other relevant information.**



# Code of conduct



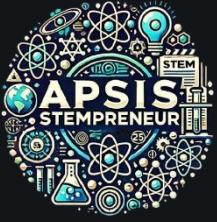
- 1. All participants are responsible for their own behaviour to ensure a successful competition; all participants must act in a manner respectful of the rights of others.**

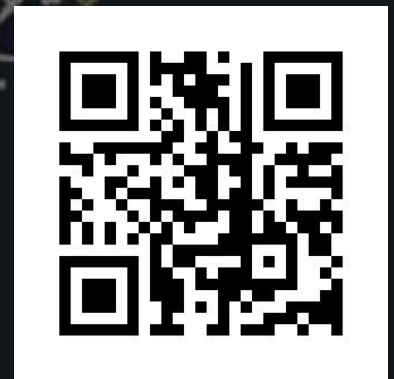
